The solid beech frame is cut using a CNC machine. The seat, back and back supports are made by form-pressing laminated veneer layers together with glue, and then cut into their final shape using a CNC machine. The entire chair is then sanded and the frame is glued together.




DISASSEMBLY

1. Remove the rubber stacking knob using pliers. Do this with caution as it is mounted with glue.

2. Remove the seat plate by unscrewing the four screws beneath the seat.
